Ms. Eugenia Kuri is currently Deputy General Director of International Affairs of Mexico's deposit insurance agency, the *Instituto para la Protección al Ahorro Bancario* (IPAB), where she has built a career since 2008.

Regarding her duties at IPAB, she is in charge of the analysis of best practices and standards in deposit insurance and bank resolutions; and the preparation of proposals for the implementation in Mexico.
